This novel begins with an allegorical tale depicting the origin of humanlike animals that evolve from purely instinctual and reactive creatures towards becoming individuals that receive the gift of sentience. These animals also absorb an inherent consciousness of individuality that includes using free will when making everyday decisions. This evolutionary advancement is instigated by superior spiritual beings called Zenithians who are responsible for the creation and evolution of all aspects of living beings within the Earthly Realm.

The rest of this spiritual thriller novel continues with the adventures of modern day individuals, called The Seekers who continue with their evolutionary journey of spiritual exploration, adventure and growth for themselves and for each other. Subsequent chapters of this story transport the reader to contemporary times and establish the novel's plot.

Because of a mysterious and deadly aircraft incident, the primary character, Adam and his co-pilot sense that there are unknown powers that influences their lives. They awaken to their new abilities with the help of enlightened souls who are residing in the Earthly realm and act as teachers, guides and friends to the Seekers and help each other in their quest.

The primary antagonist in this novel is a spiritually powerful and wealthy woman named Diana, who provides the nucleus that pulls all of the primary characters

together in a quest to discover the ruins of Atlantis, suspected to be somewhere in the Bahamas. She has a very dangerous hidden agenda that will serve as the conflict between all characters in the novel, as many of them acquire heightened spiritual powers such as reading the Akashic Record, traveling within the Spiritual Timeline and traveling in Out of the Body experiences. This novel describes these powers in detail.

This Book#1 takes the reader along on a ride that moves at a moderate pace during the first chapters where new characters are being introduced, but begins to speed up when friction between the protagonists and antagonists takes place. Towards the end of this story the novel becomes a thriller as open conflict between Diana and her followers attempt to destroy The Seekers.

This novel is an inspirational thriller for mature readers as it contains relatively complex philosophical discussions on the origin and evolutionary progress of individual souls. There are instances of great violence and disturbing activities. The storyline also describes many of the primary character's personal activities, including those of a sexual and social nature.

The **first five Chapters** of the novel introduces all of the characters and establishes their personas and capabilities and then proceeds to connect each individual to the other characters in various ways that establishes their protagonist and antagonist relationships. These characters are quite diverse in their lifestyles and interests but become aware that they are all connected spiritually and have shared many past lives. They are now being reincarnated within the present time for an all important spiritual reason to thwart an antagonists goal to accomplish something that will defer all of their spiritual advancements.

The **next five Chapters** begin to merge the activities of the book's antagonists and protagonists. Most of this activity takes place within the Bahamas as our characters become involved in exploration activities to find a lost Atlantean civilization. There is a lot of underwater exploration and scuba diving that immerse the readers into that venue. An effort has been made to describe the beauty and sensory allure of the environment of the Bahamas and it's underwater paradise including very unique cave diving activities.

The **final four Chapters** activate all of the characters and establishes their individual stances and preparation for each opposing side to promote their agendas. These chapters bring more action and conflict as each side maneuvers to dominate each other. There is violence and significant threats to the protagonists and that forces them to find solutions to protect themselves and also turn the chain of events towards their favor, by using positive spiritual solutions.

This novel introduces Quest for the Emerald Crystal-Book #1/Spiritual Warriors in the Bahamas, but allows and hints for a sequel to this novel to occur without leaving the reader to feel that the story was incomplete. The characters remain intact but some of them are damaged, whereas others are strengthened and enhanced.
