Episode Twelve

Episode 11 was an eye-opener for me, and as I had said, I was planning to travel on the Spiritual Timeline, back in time to watch young Alexander III in action during the Battle of Chaeronea. I can't believe that Alexander and his father, King Philip II, would be so focused on winning their battles that they could effectively kill off a group of warriors that they both admired above all others. I doubt they would do something like this if they lived today, but perhaps I am wrong.
